- Educate patients and their families on pain management strategies, home exercises, and injury prevention.
- Chart patient progress, evaluations, and treatment plans accurately and in a timely manner in electronic health records (EHR).
- Communicate with other healthcare professionals, colleagues, and family members to ensure coordinated care.
- Participate in ongoing professional development to stay current with the latest advancements in manual physical therapy.
